PROJECT DESCRIPTION

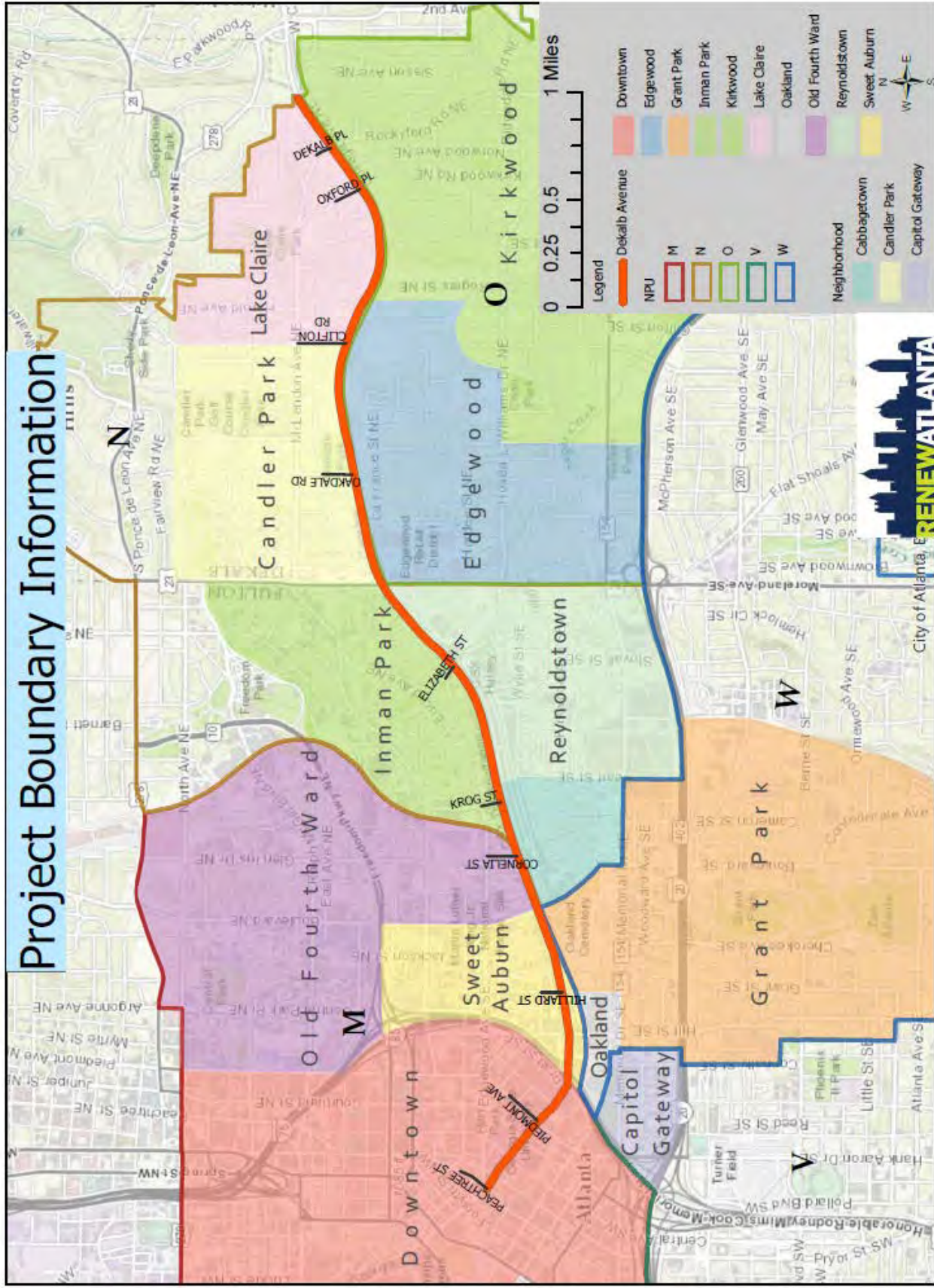
